The Alvah N. Belding Library Board of Trustees recommend candidates for appointments to the library board. Trustees are appointed with the approval of the Belding City Council. Three of the five sitting board members must be from the City of Belding, while the additional two members can be residents of our other service area townships. Full Terms are for a period of three years.

How do I get a job at the library?

Employment opportunities will appear under the "About Us" tab of our website when there is a position available. The library does not accept resumes or applications unless there is a job opening.
