SUGGESTIONS ON HOW TO START YOUR

FAMILY RESEARCH

- 1. Start with yourself. Use a pedigree chart and a family group sheet to record your family names. If you are married make out a form for the husband's family and the wife's. Use their full names put nicknames in parentheses.
- 2. Be consistent in how you record names. Write every name in full. For example "John William Smith" or "SMITH, John William". All female names should be recorded by their maiden names.
- 3. Never use numbers when recording months. The least confusing method is day first, followed by the month abbreviated to three letters, then the year in full. Example: 25 JAN 1884. (Abbreviating dates, years etc. can lead to confusion is '88 the year 1988, 1888, etc.)

WHERE TO GET YOUR INFORMATION

- 1. Talk to your family. Parents, aunts, uncles, cousins etc. Other sources at home are family Bibles, scrapbooks, photo albums, letters, and newspaper clippings.
- Go to your public library. You can get a wealth of information there. Search the census records, obituary files, military records, city directories, old phone books and last but not least the internet. Don't be afraid to ask the librarians for help.

The most important step is to have fun!
